## Composite Axle Slider Kit (DHM077) Installation for Buell 1125R

This high quality, American engineered and American manufactured slider kit was designed specifically for your Buell 1125R rear axle. Installation of the kit is straightforward.

The DHM Composite Slider kit has been shipped to you preassembled. To begin, simply remove the stainless steel socket head screws that fasten the Delrin buttons to each spindle using a 3/16" Allen wrench. Then, grasping the two spindles, one in each hand, unthread one. One will remain affixed to the all thread rod as it was installed at the factory using a thread-locking compound.

Apply one drop of the supplied thread-locking compound onto the bare end of the all thread rod. Standing at the rear of the motorcycle, insert the spindle with the all thread rod attached into the rear axle from the right side of the motorcycle until it gently bottoms against the axle. Gently thread on the left spindle until it bottoms against the axle.



Using a 7/8" open end or adjustable wrench, carefully tighten the right spindle approximately 1/4 turn while holding the left spindle with your left hand.



The replaceable Delrin buttons can now be installed by applying a drop of the supplied thread locking compound to each of the socket head screws, placing the Delrin button over the spindle, and finally inserting the screw into the spindle threads. Tighten the screws approximately 1/8 to 1/4 turn. The slider kit installation is now complete.



The sliders are made of aircraft quality 6061-T6 aluminum and Delrin. Use the same cleaner, polish, and protectors that you would use on bare aluminum and plastic. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us at [darkhorsemoto@earthlink.net](mailto:darkhorsemoto@earthlink.net)
